## JANUARY 2010

### **Leaded Window – \$75 January 5, Tuesdays 4 weeks 6:00 – 8:00 pm**

Learn how to construct windows using lead came and zinc. We'll discuss reinforcement using rebar and appropriate designs for leaded windows. You will need a soldering iron (with a rheostat if it is an uncontrolled iron), lead cutter, glass cutter, breaking pliers and glass supplies for your window. *Beginning Stained Glass is required.*

### **Beginning Stained Glass - \$75 January 6, Wednesdays 4 weeks 6:00 – 8:30pm**

In this class you will make a small panel using one of many patterns the studio provides. You will learn to cut glass using a number of techniques, learn how to use special tools designed for stained glass artists and construct your panel using the copper foil technique.

### **Box Lantern/ Panel Lamp - \$75 January 7, Thursdays 4 weeks 6:00 - 8:00 pm**

You will learn about design, construction and techniques for successful panel lamp building. Box lantern is a style of panel lamp and will give you practical experience for building 3 dimensional projects. Come in prior to the first class to select your pattern and glass so that you're ready to cut the first day of class. *Beginning Stained Glass is required.*

### **Glass Club - \$25 January 9, Saturday 10:30am**

This is our 6th year of offering a monthly gathering time for those who wish to share their experience, knowledge and stained glass projects with other glass enthusiasts. We will continue with last year's format of Zoi providing a project on the first Saturday during odd months and everyone bringing in works in progress during even months. ### **Tiffany Form Lamp - \$85 February 3, Wednesdays 6 weeks 6:00 - 8:00pm**

Build a beautiful Tiffany lamp shade using the Odyssey form system. For the first class we will discuss how to choose and use art glass in your lamp. We will skip 2 weeks after the first class to allow time for you to cut your glass. When class resumes 02/24 we will demonstrate successful techniques for grinding, foiling and solder using a lamp form. Instruction also includes applying a ring, rim and special patina treatment. Come in prior to 02/03 to select your lamp design.

If you have a glass table top or a bowling ball you would like to mosaic or would enjoy making a stained glass window without using copper foil or lead, sign up for this class.
