



# CLASSES

## SEPTEMBER 2010

### **Beginning Stained Glass - \$75 September 1, Wednesdays 4 weeks, 6:00 - 8:30pm**

In this class you will make a small panel using one of many patterns the studio provides. You will learn to cut glass using a number of techniques, learn how to use special tools designed for stained glass artists and construct your panel using the copper foil technique. Our high quality tool kit includes an 80w soldering iron, running and grozing pliers, 1 pound of 50/50 Canfield solder, a carbide wheel glass cutter, flux, flux brush and a black pen. It is discounted from \$139 to \$120 for our students. Materials for the beginner panel run \$80 on average over the 4 week class

### **Filigree Picture Frame - \$35 September 7, Tuesday 1 week, 6:00 - 8:30pm**

You will be making a picture frame using bits of scrap lead, nuggets and other glass bits you may have. Supplies needed are 1/8 U zinc, an easel back and clear float glass. You'll also need a taper file for the zinc. Bring your tool kit, too. Beginning stained glass is required.

### **Intro to Fusing - \$75 September 11, Saturdays 3 weeks 10:30am - 1:00pm**

**Week one: Jewelry - Learn how to construct a small jewelry piece out of fusible and dichroic glass.** This class introduces you to terms, firing schedules and hands-on experience with glass fusing. We'll cover glass cutting techniques for those of you who haven't taken a stained glass class and follow that with a firing demonstration for small jewelry pieces. Students will fire their own jewelry pieces during class time or other times at their convenience.

**Week two: Glass tile with stringer medium-** Using stringer medium you will be able to "draw" with glass and achieve more detail than you thought possible on your fused glass tile.

**Week three: Fused and Slumped Bowl -** To make a fused and slumped bowl you will begin by cutting out the flat components in week two of this series. In week three you will see the principles of bending and slumping your unique piece of glass into a mold. Again, all students will get the opportunity to fuse and slump their own pieces at their convenience.

### **Designing Windows Using Stock Bevels - \$55 September 14, Tuesdays 3 weeks 6:00 - 8:00pm**

Stock bevels can be used to design very decorative windows and can give a "custom" look to your windows. We will spend the first week discussing designing with bevels and the last 2 weeks building your window. Beginner or Leaded window classes are required.
